English-Chinese Translation (2) is designed for the undergraduates majoring in translation and interpretation, who have gained a general understanding of criteria of translation, nature and scope of translation, translators' qualifications, translation theories and the like, and meanwhile have acquired the relevant translation skills involved in English-Chinese translation at lexical and syntactic levels, such as amplification, omission, conversion, restructuring, to name just a few.

Description

This course, centering around English–Chinese discourses, aims to provide students with a good knowledge of discourse and more importantly, the frequently-used translation skills in the actual rendering of different genres of discourses, including news, advertisements, business and trade, legal documents, literature, etc.. There are five classroom activities on a regular basis, namely, impromptu translation, group discussion, group presentation, students' revision, teacher's comments. In addition, different versions about the same translation piece will be singled out for a comparative study in and after classroom. It is hoped that students can develop a keen awareness of discourse translation, hone up their language intuition and improve their bilingual competence after systematic instructions and constant translation practice within one semester.
